

Social Media Code of Conduct

Social Media is considered as any form of internet forums, blogs, podcasts, photographs, videos, and social bookmarking that can be found on public websites such as Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Tik Tok, VSCO, or Tumblr. Student-club/organization members are expected to conduct themselves responsibly and with integrity as members of their respective club/organization. As a student-club member, one must exhibit respectful behavior during all social media interactions, as well as display pride and respect for the college and community.

Any content that is shared must follow all acceptable social behaviors as addressed in the Student Code of Conduct Handbook. Any malicious use of social media platforms will not be tolerated. Violations of this policy will be subject to investigation and could further result in disciplinary action.

Such behavior includes:

1. Offensive language or remarks regarding fellow club/organization members, students, coaches, administrators, faculty and staff of Calhoun Community College or any other college or university.
2. The usage of verbal or symbolic expressions, which would tend to be reasonably interpreted as insulting to one's race, gender, religion, age, national origin, or disability.
3. Demeaning statements or threats that could potentially endanger the safety of another person.
4. Incriminating photos or statements regarding illegal criminal behavior, underage drinking use of illegal drugs, sexual harassment or violence.
5. Indicating knowledge of any acts listed above.
